## Trump International Golf Links—Scotland



Spanning approximately 500 hectares of land on the north-east coast of Aberdeenshire, the development comprises a world class championship links golf course suitable for hosting major international events and formed within the unique setting of Menie Estate.





## Castle Stuart Golf Links

*This Links Course opened July 2009 making this a relatively new experience and manmade links Creation that has taken the world rankings by storm.*

*This 18-hole Championship Links Course is set within 425 acres of beautiful highland countryside running along the south shore of the Moray firth with jaw dropping views from every hole. The name of the club comes from the 17th-century castle that is a 10-minute walk from the 1st tee. It is the work of two Americans, Mark Parsinen and Gil Hanse. Parsinen's wizardry is best showcased outside St. Andrews at Kingsbarns, and with the Moray Firth itself directly in the golfer's gaze on 15 holes it is a golfing experience not to be missed. Some called this the most significant golf course opening the world will see in 2009. and they were right!*





## Cruden Bay

*This is a traditional links at its very best, a stunning Scottish course. The renowned architect, Tom Simpson walked the fairways through the mountaineous dunes and created a dramatic layout that is a very stern test with some of the best playing conditions anywhere. It is a course for the serious golfer and when the wind blows, which is often, there is no place to hide.*



*With a majestic dune system that has dramatic similarities to Ballybunion, the links that run through them reveal a little of its mystery each time you play. Striking views are evident at every turn, none more memorable than Slains Castle, inspiration and setting for Bram Stoker's 'Dracula'. The idyllic setting of the Bay of Cruden and the village of Port Ellon make this a unique links, one from a bygone age.*





## *Royal Aberdeen Golf Club*

*Balgownie Links was founded as the Society of Golfers at Aberdeen in 1780 and is recognised as the 6th oldest golf club in the world.*

*It's interesting to note that the 5 minute rule for searching for a lost ball originated here. The layout is set in the classical out and back format, with the first nine on this championship Scottish links being one of the best in the world. Fast rolling fairways with a mix of heathland and marram grass outward with thick gorse and heather homebound leaving little room for the errant shot. No two holes are the same except for the common thread of beautiful seaside views.*





## Royal Dornoch Golf Club

*The course is just over 6,500 yards, and of a quality you would expect of a links that has the standard with ease to host the Open. This is a classic links test where the advantage is clearly in the hands of strategic and calculated golfers. This course is beautifully nestled in the Scottish Highlands offering breathtaking views over Dornoch Bay.*



*One of the keys to unlocking a good score here is finding the right position on the fairway leaving you the opportunity to reach the pins on these tricky sloping greens. For wild, natural beauty and a formidable challenge the links here are unequalled anywhere in the world. Records show that golf has been played here since 1616 and is consistently rated in the top 20 courses in the world.*



## *Nairn Golf Club*

*The links stretches out along the Moray Firth offering a very rewarding but extremely tough test to every standard of golfer. With a traditional links feel, meaning the first nine holes play away from the clubhouse with the back nine coming home. Every hole is memorable and there is no weakness to the links.*

*Plenty of gorse and bunkers and distracting views over the Moray Firth to the highlands this links is no push over. Quality iron shots are demanded to score well and with the putting surfaces lightening fast and probably the best greens you will experience anywhere, your putter will have to be hot.*
